



GFATM ROUND 9 INTENSIFIED MALARIA CONTROL PROJECT—II (IMCP-II)

M1 : Monthly Report of Community Health Volunteer/ Health facility

All cases of suspected malaria should be recorded in this form, irrespective of whether they are tested or treated.

Use a fresh form for each month. Start with patient number "1" each month. Use more than one sheet per month if needed. Mention sheet number. Cases that presented to you during the month should be included in that month's form, irrespective of when fever first appeared. Patients who return with symptoms within one month of starting treatment should be referred. Patients returning with symptoms after one month should be considered as new cases, recorded, tested and treated if positive.

State : District :

Main data table with columns for patient details, blood test results, treatment, and verification.

Mixed infection are to be recorded as Pf
Positive results are to be marked in Red
Use "991", "992" etc for village code when patient is not a usual resident of your village.
* in case of pregnant women refer to MPW or MO PHC

Totals will be entered by the MPH who consolidates this form to M4

Summary table with columns for Summary and cases.

Enter numbers of kits or tablets

Form with questions: Did you report an outbreak of fever in your area during the fortnight? Y / N
During the fortnight, did it happen that you could not do the RDT on any patient because you did not have RDK? Y / N
Did it happen that you could not have stocks of ACT during the fortnight? Y / N

Stock Position table with columns for RDT, Combi-blister pack, CQ, ACT packs, AS tablets, SP tablets, PQ small, PQ Large, Slides, Lancet.
